AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA,
REPEALING AND RESERVING SECTION 9-609 OF THE
FRESNO MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO THE
BUSINESS HOURS OF PAWNBROKERS AND
SECONDHAND DEALERS

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 9-609 of the Fresno Municipal Code is repealed and reserved:

SECTION 9-609. BUSINESS HOURS

[Reserved.]~~No person shall engage in, conduct, manage or carry on the
business of pawnbroker or secondhand dealer on Sundays and legal holidays, and
between the hours of seven o'clock p.m. on each day and eight o'clock a.m. of the
following morning, except that on Fridays, Saturdays and days before legal
holidays and during the twenty-four days next preceding Christmas day, each such
person may engage in, conduct, manage or carry on such business until the hour
of nine o'clock p.m.~~

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective and in full force and effect at 12:01
a.m. on the thirty-first day after its final passage.
