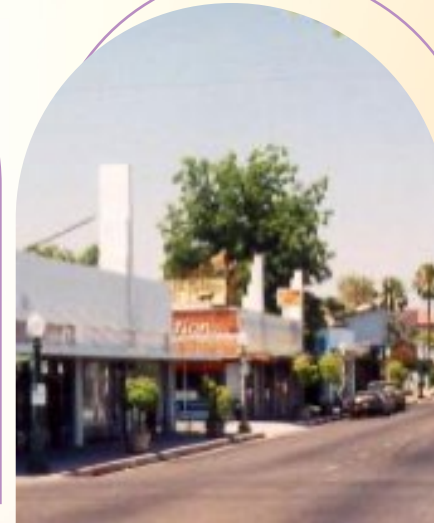

- The character started to change

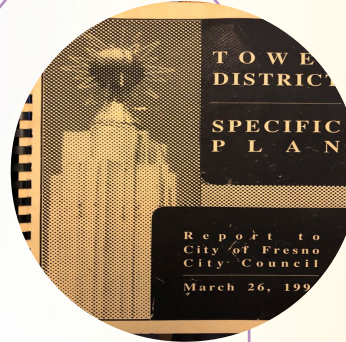


- Buildings started coming down



- What went up was not what the community desired

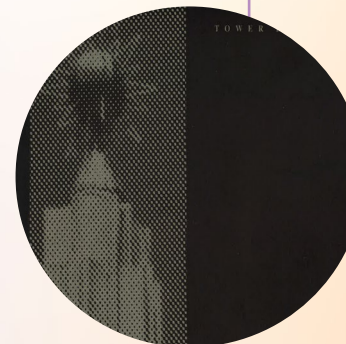
A Community's vision

- The Community Vision is Developed

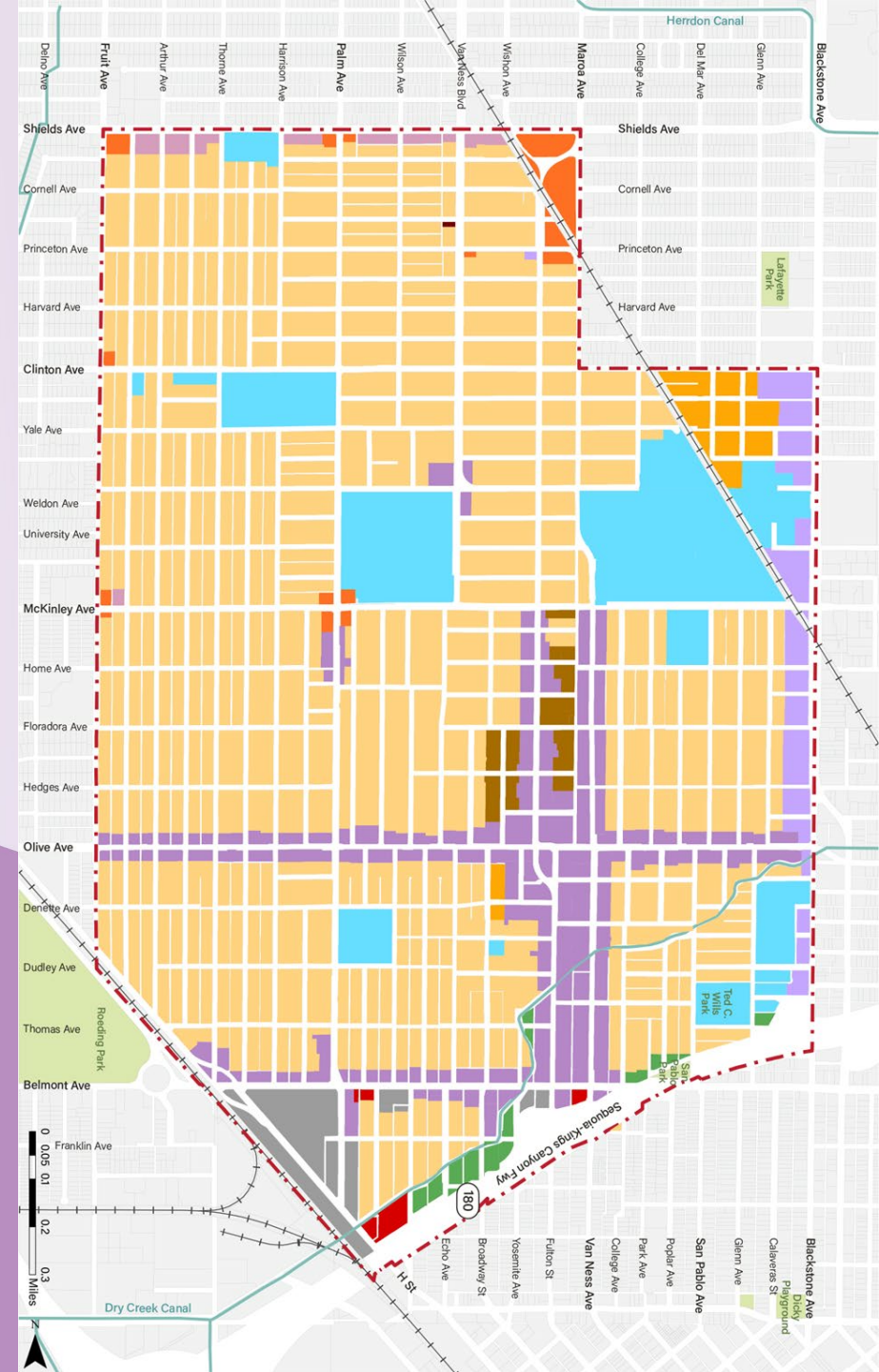
What is the tower district specific plan update?

A solid foundation

- Emphasized the importance of maintaining a pedestrian-oriented environment and in creating a community and “sense of place”
- Recognized the importance of conserving, maintaining, and enhancing the Tower’s unique historic resources
- Recognized the importance of maintaining a unique and diverse housing stock affordable to a wide range of income levels
- Established a set of zoning districts and development standards that were in line with the existing character

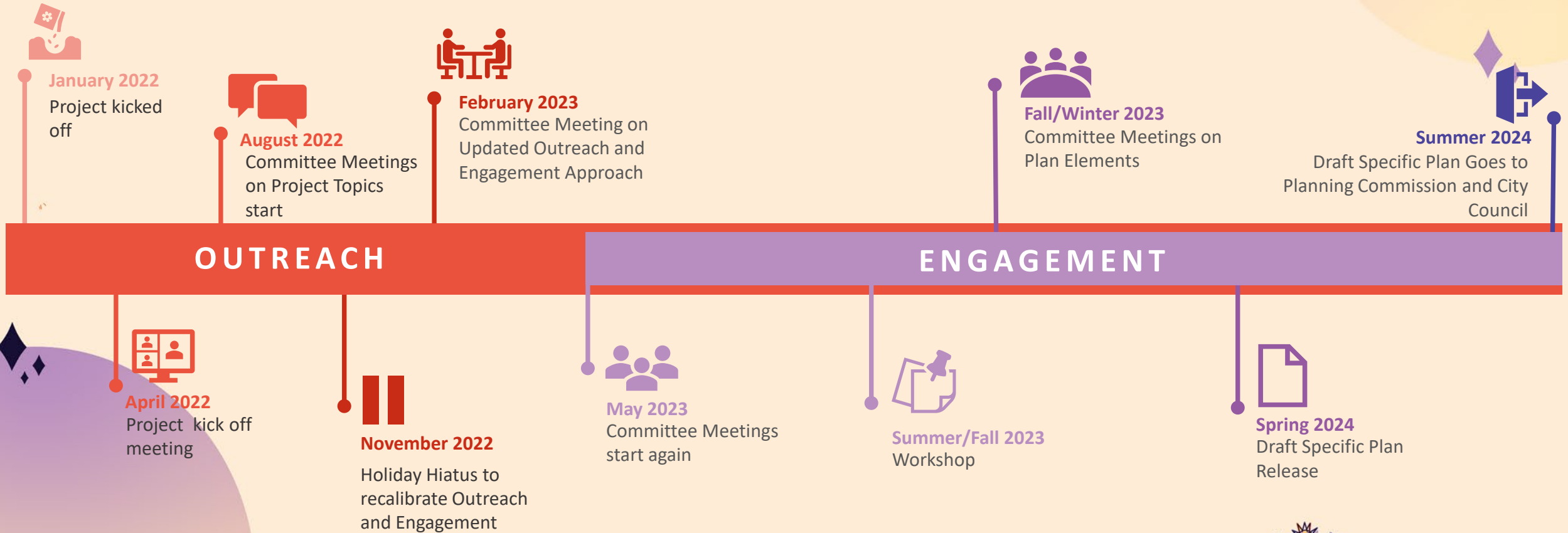
