






#### background

 Wishon ended at Olive and buildings lined the street










#### A Visual shift

 What went up was not what the community desired










Thousands signed a petition

over the next 20-30 years in


the Tower District

 Recognized the importance of conserving, maintaining, and enhancing the Tower's unique historic resources  Recognized the importance of maintaining a unique and diverse housing stock affordable to a wide range of income levels

 Established a set of zoning districts and development standards that were in line with the existing character




