A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA,
ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO
CREATE THE PROTECTED BICYCLE PARKING TASK FORCE SUBCOMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Active Transportation Advisory Committee (Committee), formerly known as the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee, serves to advise the City Council on active transportation matters to make Fresno a more active transportation friendly city.

WHEREAS, the development and implementation of strong active transportation infrastructure and policy including bikeways, walkways, secure bicycle parking, improved access to public transit, intermodal bicycle- transit coordination, and educational programs for cyclists, pedestrians and drivers to promote the safe sharing of public roadways must be given a priority in transportation planning; and

WHEREAS, the Committee seeks to establish an ad hoc subcommittee dedicated to reviewing, evaluating, and recommending strategies for integrating protected bicycle parking at cultural institutions and future development projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Active Transportation Advisory Committee as follows:

1. The Protected Bicycle Parking Task Force Subcommittee (Subcommittee) is hereby established.

2. The legal authority for creation of the Subcommittee is set forth in the Committee's Bylaws.

3. The Subcommittee shall be an advisory body; and will report back to the Committee its findings.

4. The Purpose of the Subcommittee is to review, evaluate, and recommend strategies for integrating protected bicycle parking at cultural institutions and future development projects.

5. The Subcommittee shall dissolve upon delivering to the Committee its findings.

6. The membership shall consist of

- a. No more than three Committee Members.
- b. The Chairperson shall appoint the members of the Subcommittee.
- c. Term of Office. Members serve at the pleasure of the Chair.

Membership revisions will be effective upon filing a new Organizational Form.

7. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
