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A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, DEDICATING THOSE PORTIONS OF CITY-OWNED PROPERTY FOR PUBLIC STREET PURPOSES TO ACCOMMODATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF MERCED STREET BETWEEN CONGO ALLEY AND H STREET

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno is the owner of the subject property; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this dedication is to accommodate the construction of Merced Street between Congo Alley and H Street; and

WHEREAS, the proposed areas to be dedicated as described in Exhibit A and as shown on Exhibit B, said exhibits are incorporated herein by reference and on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City at Fresno City Hall, 2600 Fresno Street, Fresno, California, 93721; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Projects Department and Public Works Department have determined that the proposed easement dedications as described in Exhibit A and as shown on Exhibit B attached herein is adequate for the proposed public street improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. That those portions of a City-owned property described in Exhibit A and as shown on Exhibit B" are hereby dedicated for the purpose of a public street easement.
- 2. Nothing contained in this resolution shall be deemed or interpreted by any party to cause any interest created in the public pursuant to this resolution to ripen into any title, interest, or right of the public against or adverse to the rights of the City of Fresno

- 4. The City Engineer shall cause a City deed number to be assigned to the resolution and shall cause the resolution to be recorded in the Office of the Recorder of the County of Fresno, California. The original resolution shall be returned to the City Clerk after recordation and a certified copy thereof shall be filed in the Public Works deed file.
 - 5. This resolution shall become effective upon final approval.

APN 466-206-29T, 31T Public Street Easement

Real property in the City of Fresno, County of Fresno, State of California, described as follows:

Parcel 1 (APN 466-206-29T):

That portion of Merced Street, in the City of Fresno, County of Fresno, State of California, abandoned by Resolution No. 67-190, recorded November 22, 1967 in Book 5503, Page 484 of Official Records Fresno County, as Document No. 80616, and more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING on the most easterly corner of said Lot 17; thence South 49°10'12" West along the Southeast line of said Lot 17, a distance of 15.24 feet to the easterly line of that portion of said Merced Street, previously abandoned and to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence South 49°10'12" West continuing on the Southeast line of said Lot 17, a distance of 59.69 feet to the westerly line thereof lying within the land described in the Corporation Grant Deed to the City of Fresno, recorded July 11, 1978 in Book 7071, Page 493 as Document No. 74634, Official Records of Fresno County; thence South 03°42'41" West across that portion of said Merced Street, previously abandoned, a distance of 40.84 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve, concave to the Northwest, and having a radius of 22.00 feet; thence southerly and southwesterly along said tangent curve, through an interior angle of 54°38'16", an arc distance of 20.98 feet to the intersection with the southerly line of that portion of said Merced Street, previously abandoned; thence South 78°24'34" East, along said southerly line, a distance of 5.81 feet to the intersection with a line which is 40.00 feet southeasterly and parallel to said Southeast line of Lot 17; thence North 49°10'12" East on said parallel line, a distance of 52.01 feet; thence North 11°35'12" East, a distance of 65.58 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Containing an area of 2,184 square feet, more or less.

Parcel 2 (APN 466-206-31T):

All of that certain portion of Merced Street lying adjacent to and Southeast of the Southeast line of Lot 17, in Block 64 of the City of Fresno, as said Street and lot are shown on the map of the Town of Fresno, filed in the Office of the County Recorder, December 10, 1888, and recorded in Volume 4, of Plats at Page 2, Fresno County Records, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING, at the most southerly corner of said Lot 17; thence, North 49°10'12" East, along the Southeast line of said Lot 17 a distance of 134.76 feet to a point which is 15.24 feet Southwest of the most easterly corner of said Lot 17; thence South 11°35'12" West, a distance of 65.58 feet to a point on the line which is 40 feet southeasterly and parallel to the southeasterly line of said Lot 17; thence South 49°10'12" West along said line a distance of

52.01 feet; thence North 78°24'34", West a distance of 50.47 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

COMMENCING on the most easterly corner of said Lot 17; thence South 49°10'12" West along the Southeast line of said Lot 17, a distance of 15.24 feet to the easterly line of that portion of said Merced Street, previously abandoned and to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence South 49°10'12" West continuing on the Southeast line of said Lot 17, a distance of 59.69 feet to the westerly line thereof lying within the land described in the Corporation Grant Deed to the City of Fresno, recorded July 11, 1978 in Book 7071, Page 493 as Document No. 74634, Official Records of Fresno County; thence South 03°42'41" West across that portion of said Merced Street, previously abandoned, a distance of 40.84 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve, concave to the Northwest, and having a radius of 22.00 feet: thence southerly and southwesterly along said tangent curve, through an interior angle of 54°38'16", an arc distance of 20.98 feet to the intersection with the southerly line of that portion of said Merced Street, previously abandoned; thence South 78°24'34" East, along said southerly line, a distance of 5.81 feet to the intersection with a line which is 40.00 feet southeasterly and parallel to said Southeast line of Lot 17; thence North 49°10'12" East on said parallel line, a distance of 52.01 feet; thence North 11°35'12" East, a distance of 65.58 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
