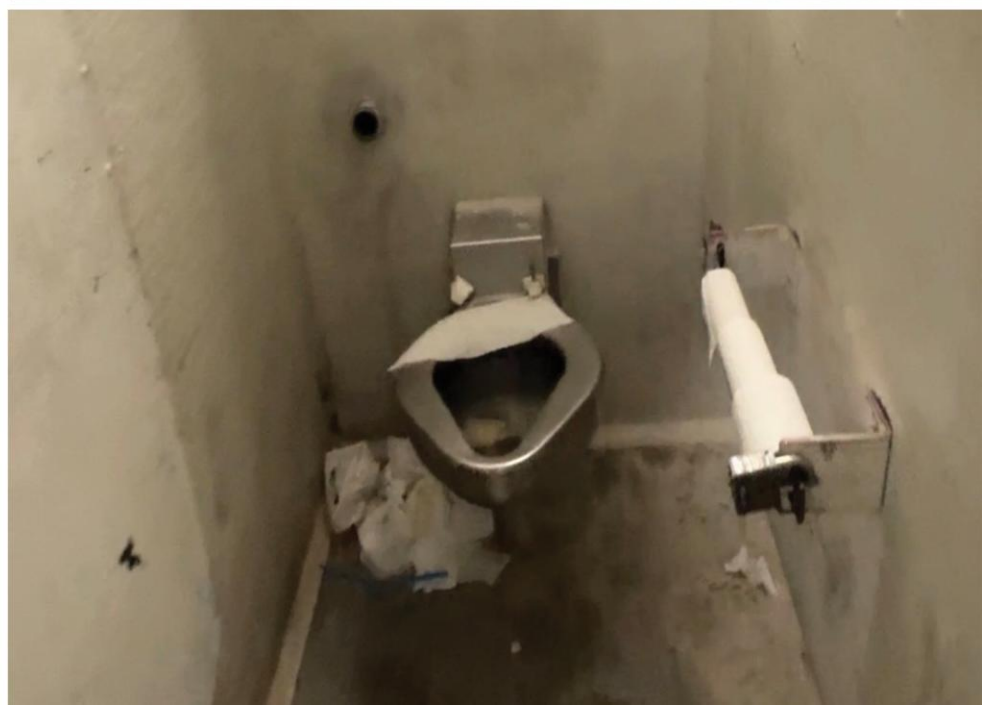


Roeding Park Tennis Courts Bathroom Experience Survey

What We Are Asking For

- **Improve short-term restroom maintenance**
- **Improve restroom safety, visibility, and oversight**
- **Community-centered planning for the future restroom project**

These Courts are an Important Community Space



Why Addressing These Concerns Matters Most NOW

- **We have been told that Measure P funds are expected to be invested into the proposed new restroom facilities**
- **If current concerns around location, visibility, orientation, and safety are not addressed now, the community may continue experiencing the same issues AFTER construction is completed**
- **Addressing these concerns BEFORE construction begins will help avoid future redesign costs, delays, and additional public spending**
- **The community wants this investment to succeed long-term!**

How would residents rate the current bathroom conditions?

55 community responses

Rating Scale: 1 = Very Poor; 5 = Excellent

89% rated the bathrooms

1 out of 5

1/5 → 49 responses

2/5 → 4 responses

3/5 → 2 responses

4/5 → 0 responses

5/5 → 0 responses

Have bathroom conditions caused residents to leave the courts early?

55 community responses

85% said **YES**

47 of 55 respondents said they have left the courts earlier than planned because of bathroom conditions.

Would Improvements to the Tennis Court Bathrooms Make Residents More Likely to Use the Courts More Often?

55 community responses

93% said **YES**

51 of 55 respondents said improvements to the tennis court
bathrooms would make them more likely to use the courts
more often.

Community Understanding of Bathroom Conditions & Plans

Project Timeline & Current Plans (Our Understanding)

- Bathrooms were originally expected to be completed in **2025**
- Community members were later told **2026**, and are now being told **next year**
- Current plans appear to keep the bathrooms in approximately the **same location**
- Current plans also appear to keep restroom entrances facing the **main roadway instead of the tennis courts**

Current Maintenance Schedule

- Scheduled restroom cleaning appears to occur only until around 2:00 PM daily, and there is no cleaning or maintenance of the bathrooms in the evenings

Key Issues Identified by Players

Safety Concerns

“The bathroom conditions are **not safe or accessible** for families to use.”

“I would never allow my 12-year-old son **to go by himself.**”

“The **restrooms are far from the tennis courts, facing away from the tennis courts, and feel unsafe to walk to at night.**”

“I never go to the bathroom alone. There are often people loitering around the bathroom area.”

“The conditions of the bathroom right now make me **very uncomfortable.**”

Leaving the Park to Avoid the Bathrooms

“The bathroom conditions are so poor that I sometimes **leave the park entirely** just to use the restroom.”

“I plan ahead and use the restroom before coming to the courts so I can **avoid having to use the bathrooms** there altogether.”

“The bathroom conditions affect how comfortably I can hydrate while playing, I **want to avoid needing to use the restrooms**, especially after sunset.”

Cleanliness, Maintenance & Bathroom Location Concerns

“It was **really dirty** with mud or excrement on the floor,
I couldn’t tell because of the darkness in there.”

“No privacy, **dirty unkept**, makes me think
no one from the parks department is around.”

Community Recommendations

Short-Term Improvement: Increase Bathroom Maintenance

- **Increase frequency** of restroom cleaning and maintenance
- **Keep restrooms stocked** with toilet paper, soap, and supplies
- **Repair** broken stall doors and locks
- **Ensure restrooms remain maintained during evening hours**
(Our understanding is that the last cleaning currently occurs around **2:00 PM.**)

Short-Term Improvement: Improve Restroom Oversight

- **Monitor** restroom areas to discourage improper use
- **Increase visibility** and oversight around restroom entrances
- **Discourage loitering** around restroom facilities
- **Keep restrooms accessible** for public use

Long-Term Improvement: Relocate & Reorient the Bathrooms

- **Relocate** bathrooms closer to the tennis courts for improved safety and visibility
- **Reorient** restroom entrances toward the courts instead of the roadway
- **Improve lighting** between the courts and restroom area
- **Design restroom entrances** with clear visibility to discourage loitering
