A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE
DOWNTOWN FRESNO (FULTON CORRIDOR) HISTORIC
RESOURCES SURVEY

WHEREAS, in 2009 the City of Fresno (the "City") embarked on a visionary goal to create and adopt several new plans and codes including an updated General Plan, a Downtown Neighborhoods Community Plan, a Citywide Development Code, and a Downtown Development Code;

WHEREAS, several special reports were also generated from this work including a Downtown Fresno (Fulton Corridor) Historic Resources Survey (the "Survey");

WHEREAS, the Survey was completed in 2011, revised in April 2014, and includes a historic context as well as 303 survey forms prepared on State of California Department of Parks and Recreation templates for properties within the Fulton Corridor Specific Plan area;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Survey was to inform the City, other municipal agencies, community groups, property owners, and developers about properties that are considered architecturally or historically significant;

WHEREAS, surveys are intended to create a baseline for land use planning and an inventory of potential historic resources but do not constitute a final determination as to the actual historic or cultural value of the properties;
