Measure C & Capital Construction

- SCCCD's Measure C Passed in 2016
\$485M
- Project list includes add'l \$30M from previous bond Measure E
- Supplemental project funding: grants (TCC), State, campus, district, SCCC Foundation = add'l \$78M in funds to bond projects

State-funded projects: Submitted through 5-Year Construction Plan

- **FCC Child Development Center (80% state)**
- RC Child Development Center (80% state)
- Clovis Applied Tech (50% state)

Scheduled Maintenance projects

- \$65M need over the next 5-years – state funded (inconsistent) and locally funded.
