CLPPP

- California Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program
 - California Department of Public Health
 - Awarded to Counties
- Purpose
 - Education
 - Outreach
 - Testing & Remediation
- To serve Children with Lead Poisoning

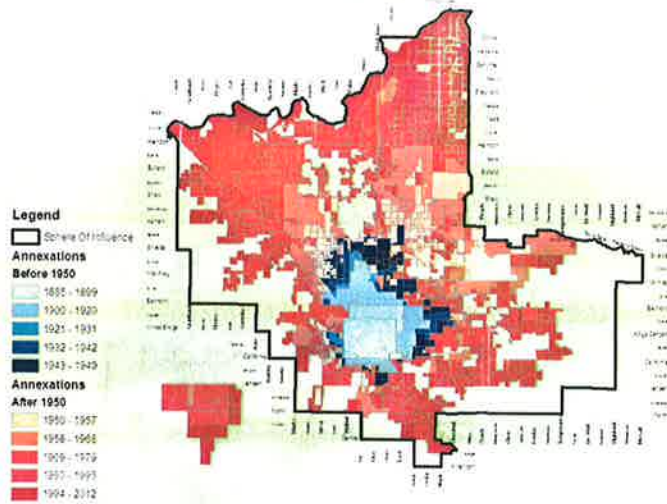
Process

- **Fresno County Health Department**
 - Identifies children with lead poisoning
 - Forwards potential participants to the City
- **DARM – Housing Division**
 - Conducts lead hazard test on residence
 - Determines participant eligibility
 - Contracts lead hazard abatement

Additional Resources

- **Federal Lead Hazard Reduction Grant**
 - Eligible city-wide
 - Unit built prior to 1978 with hazardous lead
 - Emphasis on geographical areas with high occurrences of reported lead poisoning
 - Homeowner or renter
 - Income limits apply
 - Must have a child under 6
- **Requires a 25% Match Funding**
 - CLPPP provides some of the required match
