4. MEMBER REPORTS AND COMMENTS

Board Member Vargas gave an update on paratransit vehicles. Nine new cut away buses were ordered and are housed at the yard, they should be ready for service in March 2026. These buses will replace those vehicles that are no longer in service.

Board Member Zweifler stated there was a pedestrian fatality at Clinton and Brawley due to breaks in sidewalks. This location is near the west side of Hwy 99. There are no sidewalks in some sections of the street. Dirt areas where pedestrians have to cross make it unsafe.

5. DAC SECRETARY AND ADA COORDINATOR REPORT

DAC Secretary Diane Longoria announced a meeting room change due to a conflict for the next DAC Transportation meeting on February 25. It will be located in conference room 4050 instead of 4017.

DAC Coordinator Joe Hinojosa reviewed the DAC meeting dates for 2026. The Right-of-way Transition Plan is currently being reviewed by the City Attorney's office. Once approved it will go before City Council for final approval/adoption.

Joe reached out to Transportation regarding the replacement of Kristopher

Grey. At this time, they will not be filling or replacing Kristopher Grey. The Transportation Department will assign someone to give an update on the ADA Transition Report twice a year.
