- a. Conditional Use Permit No. P25-00173 was filed by Mike De Alba of Mike De Alba and Associates on behalf of Sirisha Balijepalli of The Golf Center and pertains to ± 0.14 acres generally located north of East McKinley Avenue, between North Gateway Boulevard and North Helm Avenue, at 1817 North Helm Avenue (APN 494-310-07). The applicant seeks authorization to obtain a new Type 41 Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license (On Sale Beer & Wine Eating Place) to permit the sale of alcohol in conjunction with restaurant operations, and to establish a small-scale entertainment and recreational golf facility, to be operated under the name The Golf Center. The proposed hours of operation are 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM Monday to Sunday with alcohol to be served during these same hours. The proposal includes modifications to the existing $\pm 2,930$ -square-foot tenant space, which will include the addition of a $\pm 1,729$ -square-foot second floor. The tenant space will feature a restaurant with a bar, an indoor putting green, and seven spaces for golf simulators. The parcel is currently zoned IL (Light Industrial).
