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BACKGROUND OF PROJECT (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

The Municipal Fleet Division is responsible for purchasing and maintaining tires for the City's fleet of vehicles. Retreads are used tires (i.e. "casings") that have received a new tread. Casings are first inspected to ensure they are in suitable condition. The worn tread is buffed away, and a new tread is bonded to the casing in a manner similar to how a new tire is made. Tire retreading practices have improved to the point where retread tires perform similar to new tires. The proven safety and reliability of today's retreads, along with their favorable economics compared to new tires, is spurring continued retreading growth. The environmental and economic benefits of retreading supported establishment of a Federal Executive Order (13149) mandating use of retreads on government vehicles whenever possible.

The Department of Transportation, Municipal Fleet Division, is in need of a contract for the purchase of retread tires for the City's fleet. Last year the Municipal Fleet purchased over 1,000 retread tires, ranging from \$175 to \$200 each. Establishing a competitively bid multi-year contract for the retread tires needed will keep prices stable, and allow for consistent budgeting for the term of the contract.

DEPARTMENT CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATION:
