FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE CITY  
MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO RENEGOTIATE  
THE CITYWIDE PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENT FOR  
PUBLIC WORKS IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno entered into a Citywide Project Labor Agreement (PLA) on September 29, 2021, with the Fresno, Madera, Kings and Tulare Counties Building and Construction Trades Council (Trades Council).

WHEREAS, the PLA provides uniform wages, benefits, overtime pay, hours, working conditions, and work rules for work on major construction projects, as well as providing reliable and uninterrupted qualified workers at predictable costs; and

WHEREAS, the PLA is helping to develop qualified workers in the construction trades and include people who are historically underrepresented in the trades; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to direct the City Manager to renegotiate and extend the agreement term of the PLA with the Trades Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The City Manager and City Attorney are requested to renegotiate the PLA.
2. This Resolution shall give the administration the authority to renegotiate the PLA, with the understanding that the final terms and language of the amendment are subject to Council review and approval. The renegotiated PLA shall be brought to
