WHEREAS, utilizing his entrepreneurial talents, Jet empower residents with graffiti cleanup kits and organizing volunteer "paint outs." He transformed graffiti abatement into a collaborative effort between the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, after 35 years of exemplary service, Jet retired on March 21, 2025, leaving behind a legacy of public service commitment, innovative leadership, community engagement, and unwavering commitment to the City of Fresno that improved the quality of life for all residents, and beautified Fresno.
