*Committee discussion on the item included: concerns about data context; the long term structure of the task force; the need for measurable goals and clearer crash factors; questions about LPI policy; proactive post crash response and drivers disabling vehicle safety technology; concerns about the resources and budget challenges; the importance of continued community involvement; prioritization for planning and coordination; the use of ghost bikes as visual memorials; analyzation of bike versus pedestrian*

*fatality locations; the need for establishing defined timelines, measurable outcomes; clarification on the costs needed to implement the plan.*
