A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA AMENDING CERTAIN DETAILS
RELATED TO THE COMMISSION ON FAMILY
AFFORDABILITY AND CHILDCARE ACCESS

WHEREAS, the Council created the Commission on Family Affordability and
Childcare Access (the Commission) by Resolution during a Special Meeting on June 8,
2026; and

WHEREAS, the Council now wishes to amend certain details related to the
structure and meeting requirements of the Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as
follows:

1. The total number of Commissioners is increased to 11, comprised of eight
Community Commissioners and three Council Commissioners.
2. During a regular Commission meeting, each Commissioner may appoint an
alternate to attend meetings of the Commission when the Commissioner does not attend,
which shall stand in the shoes of the Commissioner when attending on their behalf.
Alternates shall have the power to vote and act as proxy for the Commissioners. Such
alternates shall serve at the pleasure of the Commissioner and may be removed or
replaced during any regular Commission meeting.
3. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
