BACKGROUND:

On June 1, 2016 the City advertised and sent out more than one hundred requests to consulting firms to submit “Statement of Qualification and Cost Proposal for the design of sewer rehabilitation/replacement on Hammond Avenue and Abby Street. Seven firms submitted the necessary qualifications and of the seven firms six submitted the cost proposal to the City on June 27, 2016. The City of Fresno Wastewater Management Division (WMD) Technical Services concluded that all seven firms have the necessary experience and qualifications the City requires without conducting an interview on July 5, 2016.

EVALUATION BY COMMITTEE:

After reviewing all of the statement of qualifications and cost proposals, it was determined that Blair, Church & Flynn was the most qualified, experienced and submitted the lowest design cost to the City for the sewer replacement/rehabilitation design on Hammond Avenue and Abby Street compare to the other firms.

RECOMMENDATION

City of Fresno, WMD recommend awarding the design contract to Blair, Church and Flynn.
