## 4. PROJECT REVIEW - NEW MATTERS

a. Conditional Use Permit Application No. P25-01134 was filed by Dirk Poeschel of Dirk Poeschel Land Development Services on behalf of Dionysos Stefanopoulos of Aeronot Studio LLC and pertains to the  $\pm 2.96$  acre lot located at the northeast corner of West Shaw and North College Avenues at 280 West Shaw Avenue (APN 417-333-04). The applicant is requesting authorization to establish a  $\pm 6,450$  square-foot event center within an existing building, with a  $\pm 9,400$  square-foot outdoor courtyard with an outdoor pizza oven located on the northeast portion of the property, two (2) designated taco truck parking stalls with hookups in the parking lot, and landscaping along the West Shaw and North College Avenue frontages. Additionally, the applicant is requesting authorization to establish a State of California Type 47 Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license (On-Sale General - Eating Place), which authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for both on-site and off-site consumption. The parcel is zoned CMX (Corridor-Center Mixed-Use).
