A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, RENAMING THE SOUTH TOWER
PARK TO THE BROADWAY PARQUE

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (City) owns a vacant property located at the corner of N. Broadway and E. Elizabeth commonly known as the South Tower Park; and

WHEREAS, the future park will be a neighborhood hub, where community residents can gather; and

WHEREAS, the engaged group of residents of South Tower District, commonly known as the Broadway Parque Committee, have requested a park for years and have assisted with the creation of their own park design; and

WHEREAS, the future park will be an initiative led by the community alongside the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to recognize the Broadway Parque Committee for its support in bringing a park to the local community; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Fresno Municipal Code Section 5-101 the Council has the ability to name or rename public facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The park currently known as the South Tower Park shall hereafter be named Broadway Parque.
2. This resolution is adopted in accordance with Section 8 of Administrative Order 6-2.

3. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
