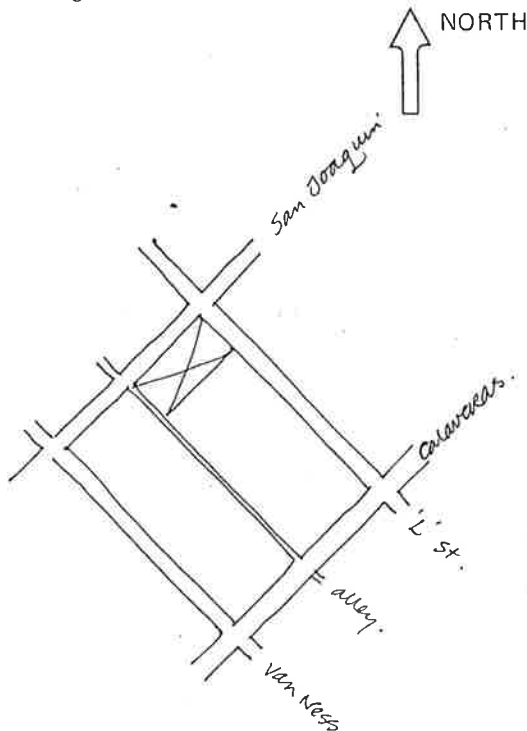
DESCRIPTION

Wood shingled building surmounted by a gambrel type roof with dormers. Square and circular bay windows project from the structure in numerous areas. Wood shingled roof. Building is surrounded by very nice trees and shrubs - none of vintage original to building.

Stylistically, a very difficult building to describe. It incorporates elements of revival and shingle style, but is a very individualistic statement.
