A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FROM CALIFORNIA VOLUNTEERS YOUTH SERVICE CORPS PROGRAM GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,186,147 FOR THE ONE FRESNO YOUTH JOBS CORPS PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO SIGN ALL NECESSARY IMPLEMENTING DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, The OneFresno Youth Jobs Corps Program was launched in Spring of 2022 with \$7.4 million awarded by California Volunteers and the State of California; and

WHEREAS, The City was awarded \$3,014,593 million on April 24, 2024, to continue providing this valuable program to the community. The award and agreement was accepted by Council on May 23, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City was notified on March 13, 2025, that California Volunteers planned to award the City of Fresno an additional \$3,186,147 for the City's allocation for the Youth Service Corps program for fiscal year 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, the City must enter into an amended agreement with the Governor's Office of Service and Community Engagement (GO-Serve) to participate in the program and receive the funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:



1. The Council authorizes the City Manager or designee to accept grant funds and sign all necessary implementing documents from California Volunteers Youth Service Corps Program Grant for the Youth Service Corps program for fiscal year 2024-2025.
2. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
