BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

THAT the Master Fee Schedule Resolution No. 80-420 be and is hereby amended to adjust residential solid waste rates in the Solid Waste Rates section of the Public Utilities Department as authorized by Resolution No. 2024- _____, which adopted updated solid waste rates in accordance with Proposition 218, and Resolution No. 2024 - _____ which adopted the Solid Waste Affordability Credit for Income Qualified Customers. The revised pages of the Master Fee Schedule are attached as Exhibit "A" and are hereby incorporated by reference and made a part of this Resolution.

THAT the fees adjusted by this Resolution and the Solid Waste Affordability Credit for Income Qualified Customers shall become effective on July 1, 2024.

THAT beginning July 1, 2025, through July 1, 2028, staff shall administratively update the designated fees adjusted by this resolution, in accordance with the five year rate schedule adopted by Resolution No. 2024-_____, annually on July 1.
