# a. Conditional Use Permit Application No. P25-02582 / Planned Development Application No. P25-02715

Conditional Use Permit Application No. P25-02582 was filed by Drew Metz of NJA Architecture on behalf of the Fresno Chaffee Zoo and pertains to  $\pm$  2.57 acres located at 480 N Teilman Ave, Fresno, CA 93706; APN 458-114-02. The Project proposes to develop the site with a  $\pm$  17,000 square foot maintenance building; two (2)  $\pm$  1,000 square foot greenhouses; one (1)  $\pm$  4,320 square foot solar carport; one (1)  $\pm$  3,272 square foot solar carport; one (1)  $\pm$  2,880 square foot solar carport; a  $\pm$  1.0-acre laydown (outdoor storage) yard; associated screening walls; parking areas; trash enclosure; drive-approaches; landscaping; and other on- and off-site improvements necessary for operation and to comply with the development code. The parcel is zoned NMX (Neighborhood Mixed-Use).

Associated Planned Development Application No. P25-02715 requests authorization to deviate from various Fresno Municipal Code development requirements including setback and frontage requirements contained in Table 15-1103; sidewalk requirements contained in Section 15-1103(F); screening wall material requirements contained in Section 15-2013(D); and location and screening requirements contained in Section 15-2721(C)(2&3).
