FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT ("Amendment") made and entered into as of this day of, 2015, amends the Agreement entered into between the CITY OF FRESNO, a municipal corporation, ("CITY"), and WestCare California, Inc., a California 501(c)(3) not-for-profit Corporation, ("RECIPIENT").
RECITALS
CITY and RECIPIENT entered into an Agreement, dated January 29, 2015, to provide assistance to the homeless, and those at risk of becoming homeless, to quickly regain stability in permanent housing after experiencing a housing crisis and/or homelessness within the city; and
CITY and RECIPIENT now desire to modify RECIPIENT's compensation and modify the time of completion.
AGREEMENT
NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recitals, which recitals are contractual in nature, the mutual promises herein conditioned, and for other good and valuable consideration hereby acknowledge, the parties agree that the aforesaid Agreement be amended as follows:
1. The term of the Agreement is extended to June 30, 2016, and the completion date changed from August 15, 2015, to June 30, 2016.
2. RECIPIENT's sole compensation for satisfactory performance of all services required or rendered pursuant to this Amendment shall be a total fee of \$464,426.
3 Except as otherwise provided herein, the Agreement entered into by CITY and CONSULTANT, dated January 29, 2015, remains in full force and effect.
4. In the event of any conflict between the body of this Amendment and any Exhibit or Attachment hereto, the terms and conditions of the body of this Amendment shall control and take precedence over the terms and conditions expressed within the Exhibit or Attachment. Furthermore, any terms or conditions contained within any Exhibit or Attachment hereto which purport to modify the allocation of risk between the parties, provided for within the body of this Amendment, shall be null and void.
