

## Conditional Use Permit Application No. C-17-79

- Requests to upgrade an existing Type 20 alcohol license (Package Store – sale of beer and wine for consumption off the premises where sold) to a Type 21 alcohol license (Package Store – sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption off the premises where sold) for the existing Johnny Quik Food Store and Gas Station.
- Use (alcohol sales) not permitted per Conditions of Zoning.
- Project does not meet location restrictions pursuant to FMC Section 15-2706-E.
  - The Director & Planning Commission were unable to make findings for exception from location restrictions.
  - The Director & Planning Commission were unable to make CUP findings a, b, c, d, & e pursuant to FMC Section 15-5306.
