RAZOR WIRE TEXT AMENDMENT

City Council - May 2nd, 2024

PURPOSE

- Resolution No. 2019-248
 - Initiated to provide additional security measures for businesses where security fencing is permitted

PROPOSED CHANGES

- Amends Section 15-2009 of the Fresno Municipal Code:
 - Where required by law
 - To contain livestock
 - Commercial Districts (unless visible from a street, highway or open space)
 - Industrial Districts (unless it abuts a Residential District)
- Additional Location Restrictions:
 - Prohibited within 1,000 feet of sensitive uses including Residential Districts, public or private schools, daycares, churches, and public parks
 - Except for the keeping of livestock and on construction sites as a temporary measure


