Background *(Explain the need for the procurement below.)*

The City of Fresno has identified the need for a roadway restoration project along Shaw Avenue, spanning from Fruit Avenue to about 950 feet east of Palm Avenue. The purpose of this project is to extend the lifespan of a heavily travel arterial road through pavement rehabilitation. Improvements include pavement restoration, curb ramp improvements, median nose adjustments, traffic loop replacement, and updated signage and striping. Approval of the construction contract, totaling \$1,636,501 and award Cal Valley Construction Inc. of Fresno, California, will enable the project to move into the construction phase. This project is federally through the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) and Senate Bill (SB1) Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funds.

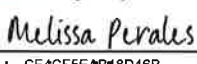
