BACKGROUND

The City of Fresno's (City) Information Service Department (ISD) seeks bids for technology services and support in a variety of technical realms. The City's ISD team has broad responsibilities for selecting, installing, maintaining, and operating technology across the city. In support of these responsibilities and ISD's goals to provide secure, reliable, and robust services to our internal customers and citizens, ISD has developed this RFP in order to identify and select qualified bidders who will work in concert with the ISD team on the planning and execution projects, providing of services, and support for the city's 24x7x365 operational requirements.

To that end ISD sought responses from bidders to provide the following hardware services in the areas listed below.

- Removal
- Related services

EVALUATION METRICS

In order to establish what we believe represented best value for the City, the following factors were identified for evaluation:

- 1. Cost the reasonableness and competitiveness of the total price for services rendered to the City.
- 2. Ability to Meet the Stated Service Requirements the providers' ability to deliver on the stated requirements in the Scope of Work (SOW), based on review of the documents provided, supplemental question (RFP Proposal Questions separate doc), demonstrations, etc.
- 3. <u>Past Performance and Experience</u> based on the references and experiences shown on "Statement of Qualifications and Experience"

- 4. Conformance to the terms and conditions of the RFP
- <u>5.</u> <u>Financial Stability</u> based on the Statement of Qualifications and Experience.
- <u>6.</u> Other related information aspects of the products or services offered, above the standards of the RFP, that improved the overall value proposition

Alpha Omega offered very competitive rates for their work. Experience with Alpha Omega has been positive and the assessment of their proposal was generally positive. We believe that Alpha Omega can offer services that would benefit the city.

AMS.Net's cost for the services bid outpaced the costs of Alpha Omega, for similar services. As compared to the balance of the bidders for this RFP, AMS was the sole bidder for few services. AMS.Net has a well-established relationship with the city. Due to the unique services they bid, and the relationship with the city, we believe AMS.Net's proposal has some benefit, but is otherwise not cost competitive.

Cook's Communication - Cook's Communication bid in one area:

Licensed and Unlicensed Radio Base Stations / Land Mobile Radio

Cook's was the sole bidder in this area. Further, the city has a long history of working with Cook's on radio systems. We believe that Cook's bid offers value to the city.

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the bid documents, bidder interviews, existing experience with the bidders, and reference checks, the committee recommends that all bidders be selected under this RFP and be given the opportunity to do business with the City of Fresno. The committee recommends awarding the requirements contract to all bidders, not to exceed \$250,000, among all three.
