# BACKGROUND

- **Street Name Change Application No. P26-00936 proposes reverting Cesar Chavez Boulevard to:**
  - **California Avenue**
  - **Ventura Street**
  - **Kings Canyon Road**
- **Affects a 6.9-mile corridor from West Cesar Chavez Boulevard/South Marks Avenue to South Peach Avenue**
  - **Excludes the segment between South Hughes Avenue and South West Avenue (Already West California Avenue)**

# BACKGROUND CONT'D

On March 23, 2026, Council approved Resolution No. 2026-42

- Directs reversions to original street names (Kings Canyon Road, Ventura Street, and California Avenue)

# EXISTING ADDRESSES ON CESAR CHAVEZ BOULEVARD

- **If approved, the street name will be updated for all addresses within the Cesar Chavez Boulevard corridor that currently use that designation.**
- **Notice of Address Change letters will be mailed to all affected property owners and tenants before implementation.**
  - **Only the street name will change; address numbers and directionals will remain the same (e.g., 555 E. Cesar Chavez Blvd → 555 E. Kings Canyon Rd).**
- **The City will notify all relevant City departments and outside agencies (Police, Fire, Public Utilities, Business License & Tax, USPS, County Assessor, PG&E, Elections, Sheriff's Department).**
- **Property owners and tenants are responsible for updating personal records such as banking, driver's licenses, credit cards, and phone accounts.**

- **April 3, 2026:** Dual Public Hearing Notice for Planning Commission and City Council was published in the Fresno Bee Newspaper.
- **April 15, 2026:** Planning Commission Hearing regarding Street Name Change.

# STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the CITY COUNCIL take the following actions:

1. **CONSIDER** and **ADOPT** the determination of Categorical Exemption Section 15301/Class 1, Section 15302/Class 2 under Environmental Assessment No. P26-00936.1 **or** the Finding of No Possibility of Significant Effect under Section 15061(b)(3) as prepared for Environmental Assessment No. P26-00936 dated April 15, 2026, in accordance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.
2. **RESOLUTION** – To approve Street Name Change Application No. P26-00936 in accordance with Article 62, Chapter 15 of the Fresno Municipal Code
