FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT (Amendment) made and entered into as of this ____ day of May 2018, amends the Agreement heretofore entered into between the CITY OF FRESNO, a municipal corporation (City), and WILLDAN ENGINEERING, a California Corporation (Consultant).

RECITALS

City and Consultant entered into an Agreement, dated November 15, 2013, for professional traffic and civil engineering services for the design of plans and general construction contract documents for a New Traffic Signal at the Intersection of Shields Avenue and Weber Avenue, (Agreement);

Consultant has completed Parts One, Two, and Three of the Agreement; and City and Consultant now desire to modify the scope of work, therein, by requiring additional services.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree that the Agreement be amended as follows:

- 1. Consultant shall provide additional services as described in **Attachment A**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Such additional services shall be completed within 20 calendar days following execution of this Amendment by both parties.
- 2. Consultant's sole compensation for satisfactory performance of all services required or rendered pursuant to this Amendment shall be a total fee of \$3,980.00.
- 3. In the event of any conflict between the body of this Amendment and any Exhibit or Attachment hereto, the terms and conditions of the body of this Amendment shall control and take precedence over the terms and conditions expressed within the Exhibit or Attachment. Furthermore, any terms or conditions contained within any Exhibit or Attachment hereto which purport to modify the allocation of risk between the parties, provided for within the body of this Amendment, shall be null and void.
- 4. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Agreement entered into by City and Consultant, dated November 15, 2013, remains in full force and effect.
