A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS FOR CALRECYCLE GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS, INCLUDING UP TO \$350,000 ANNUALLY FOR WASTE TIRE ENFORCEMENT, UP TO \$100,000 PER TWO-YEAR GRANT TERM FOR WASTE TIRE CLEANUP, AND UP TO \$40,000 PER TWO-YEAR GRANT TERM FOR WASTE TIRE AMNESTY, AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDING IN AMOUNTS TO BE DETERMINED BY CALRECYCLE, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY AND/OR DESIGNEE TO SIGN ALL NECESSARY IMPLEMENTING DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the State, thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, award, and administration of the grant programs; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney's Office desires to apply for CalRecycle grant program funds, including up to \$350,000 annually through the Waste Tire Enforcement

Grant, up to \$100,000 per two-year grant term through the Waste Tire Cleanup Grant, and up to \$40,000 per two-year grant term through the Waste Tire Amnesty Grant; and

WHEREAS, if successful, the City of Fresno will enter into a grant agreement(s) with CalRecycle for implementation of the grant program(s).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The Council of the City of Fresno authorizes the City Attorney and/or designee to sign and submit grant applications to CalRecycle for Local Government Waste Tire Enforcement, Waste Tire Cleanup, and Waste Tire Amnesty grant program funds in total amounts determined by CalRecycle after evaluation of the City's grant proposals.

2. If the applications for CalRecycle grant program funding are approved, the City Attorney and/or designee, is authorized to accept the award(s) and directed to enter into, execute, and deliver on behalf of the City, any and all other agreements or documents reasonably required or deemed necessary or appropriate to evidence, secure, and accept the grant funds, and all amendments thereto.

3. If the applications for CalRecycle grant program funding are approved and accepted, the City is authorized to incur grant-related expenses and receive reimbursement for those expenses; as well as authorize future amendments, if any, for the purpose of increasing funding provided to the City in the original agreement, without an additional resolution from the Council.

4. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval and the authorization contained in this resolution shall continue in effect for a duration of five years.
