Department Recommendation

Background (Explain the need for the procurement below.)

The California State Senate Bill (SB) 1383 requires local jurisdictions to purchase recycled organic mulch/compost products and/or energy credits derived from using recycled mulch/compost products to create energy. SB 1383 requires the City of Fresno based upon the population to purchase 43,742 tons of organic waste. One ton of Mulch is equivalent to 650 kwh of Electricity from Biomass conversion.

SB 1383 compliance is required of all jurisdictions throughout the State of California, there are very limited options to meet procurement requirements compliance anywhere in the State. Funding for this requirement is also limited, and the city is not able support additional cost related to this item. The recommendation of the department is to accept the lowest bid from California Wood Recycling, with no additional operation cost related to delivery and storage of material to meet the state requirement by end of December 2025.

The recommendation from the Department is to go with Bidder #1 lowest bid.
