The acquisition of 16,088 square feet of permanent street easement and 6,534 square feet of temporary construction easement on property owned by Antonio Petrosino in the amount of \$82,200 (APN 579-074-30S) for the construction of a multi-purpose trail as well as landscape and irrigation along Copper Avenue from Maple to Chestnut Avenues. The Fresno General Plan designates this portion of Copper Avenue with a Class 1 Bicycle/Pedestrian path. The proposed acquisitions are related to construction of this approved facility along

Copper Avenue, which is already developed.
