A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, CLARIFYING THE APPLICABILITY OF COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT 18

WHEREAS, under the terms of the City of Fresno Special Tax Financing law (Chapter 8, Division 1, Article 3 of the Fresno Municipal Code), (the Code) and the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982 (Sections 53311 and following, California Government Code; hereafter referred to as the Act), the City Council of the City of Fresno (the City) may commence proceedings for the establishment of a community facilities district; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2022, the City of Fresno adopted Resolution No. 2022-279 directing the formation of Community Facilities District 18 (CFD 18) to fund police and fire services for new developments; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to adopt a policy and provide clarification regarding the application of CFD 18.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. This resolution clarifies that CFD 18 shall only be applicable to new annexations to the City occurring after August 29, 2020.
- 2. This resolution does not apply to projects approved through development agreements.
 - 3. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
