A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING AND ADOPTING  
THE FRESNO TRAIL NETWORK EXPANSION  
FEASIBILITY PLAN AND THE CORRIDOR  
RECOMMENDATIONS CONTAINED THEREIN

Whereas, the Council of the City of Fresno (Council) adopted the Fresno Active Transportation Plan (ATP) on March 2, 2017, as a comprehensive guide outlining the vision for active transportation in the City of Fresno (City); and

Whereas, the ATP identifies over 166 miles of Class I trails as part of the recommended active transportation network, designed to serve human-powered travel including walking, bicycling, and wheelchair use; and

Whereas, on March 2, 2017, concurrent with adopting the ATP, Council adopted the Active Transportation Prioritization Tool (the ATP Tool) to be used to evaluate and prioritize individual trail corridors and/or segments to be built out within the City; and

Whereas, utilizing Caltrans Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant Program grant funds, together with already available matching Measure "C" Trails funding, the City has completed the Fresno Trail Network Expansion Feasibility Plan (the Feasibility Plan) attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

Whereas, the Feasibility Plan, utilizing the ATP Tool, builds upon the City's efforts to develop a Class I bikeway (multi-purpose trails) network proposed in the ATP and specifically identifies the following five (5) corridors and/or segments as being of the highest priority:

Corridor A: Herndon Canal from Hughes Avenue to Fruit Avenue

Corridor B: Kearney Boulevard from West Avenue to Fresno Street

Corridor C: Merced Street from Thorne Avenue to B Street, Throne Avenue  
from Merced Street to California Avenue

Corridor D: California/Walnut to Hinton Park

Corridor E: Church and Jensen from Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to Elm  
Avenue
