About Us

The Animal Center was built by the City of Fresno to provide state-mandated animal control services. Our Center provides temporary kennels for Fresno's homeless pet population while they wait to be reclaimed by their owners. If unclaimed, the pet is then adopted into a forever home.

Mission

Our mission is to increase live outcomes for animals by reducing the euthanasia rate. With guidance from our partners, we strive to reunite pets with their owners by providing resources to City of Fresno residents.

Under the resolution approved unanimously by the City Council on December 7, 2023, the city-owned Fresno Animal Center has temporarily halted accepting healthy lost or stray dogs and cats because it is overcrowded and understaffed, posing a health hazard for animals in its care. The moratorium was put in place in early December 2023 with no estimate on when the shelter would resume taking in healthy animals.

The city of Fresno remains responsible for picking up aggressive or vicious dogs requiring quarantine, as well as strays that are injured or sick, as mandated by state law.

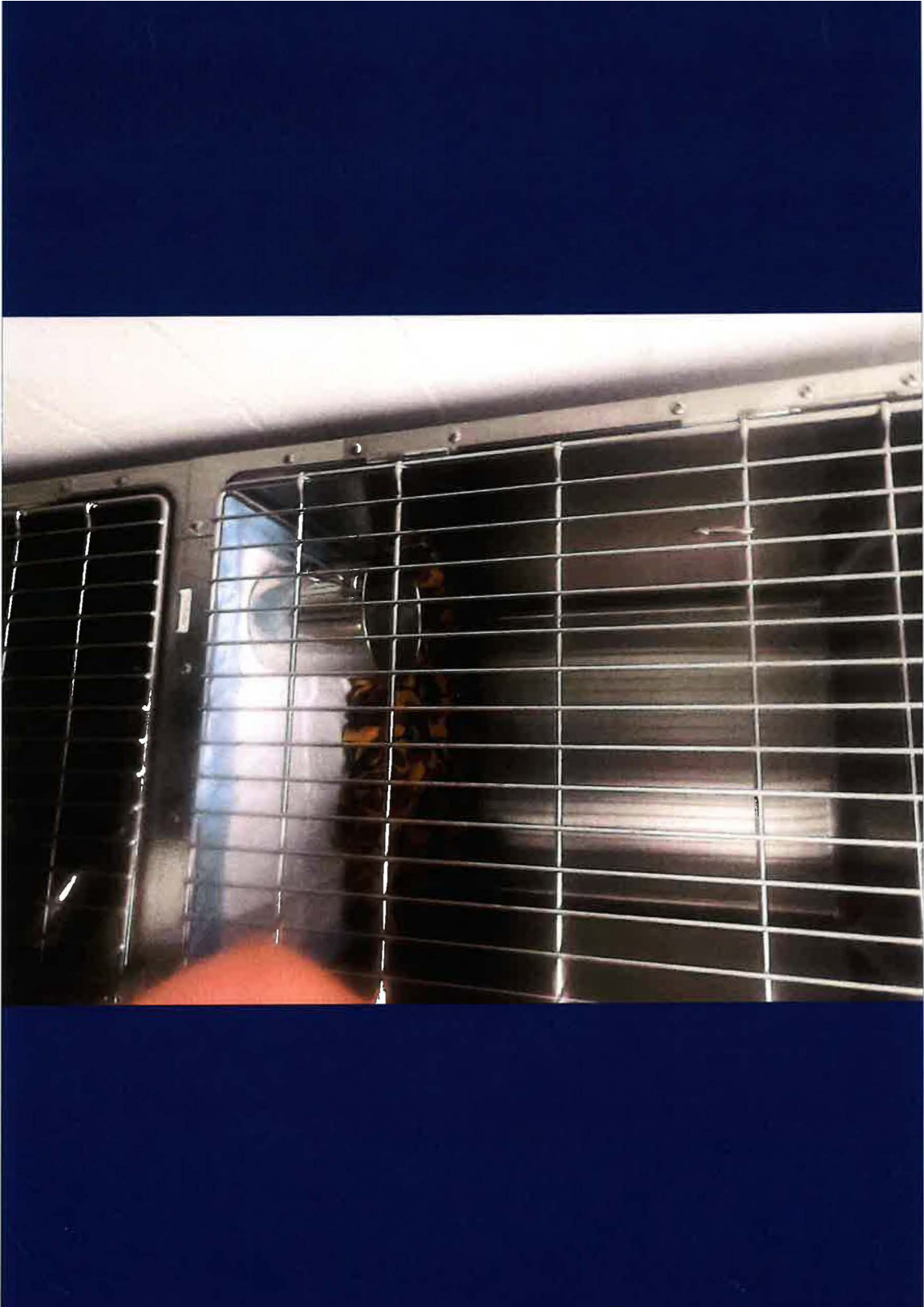

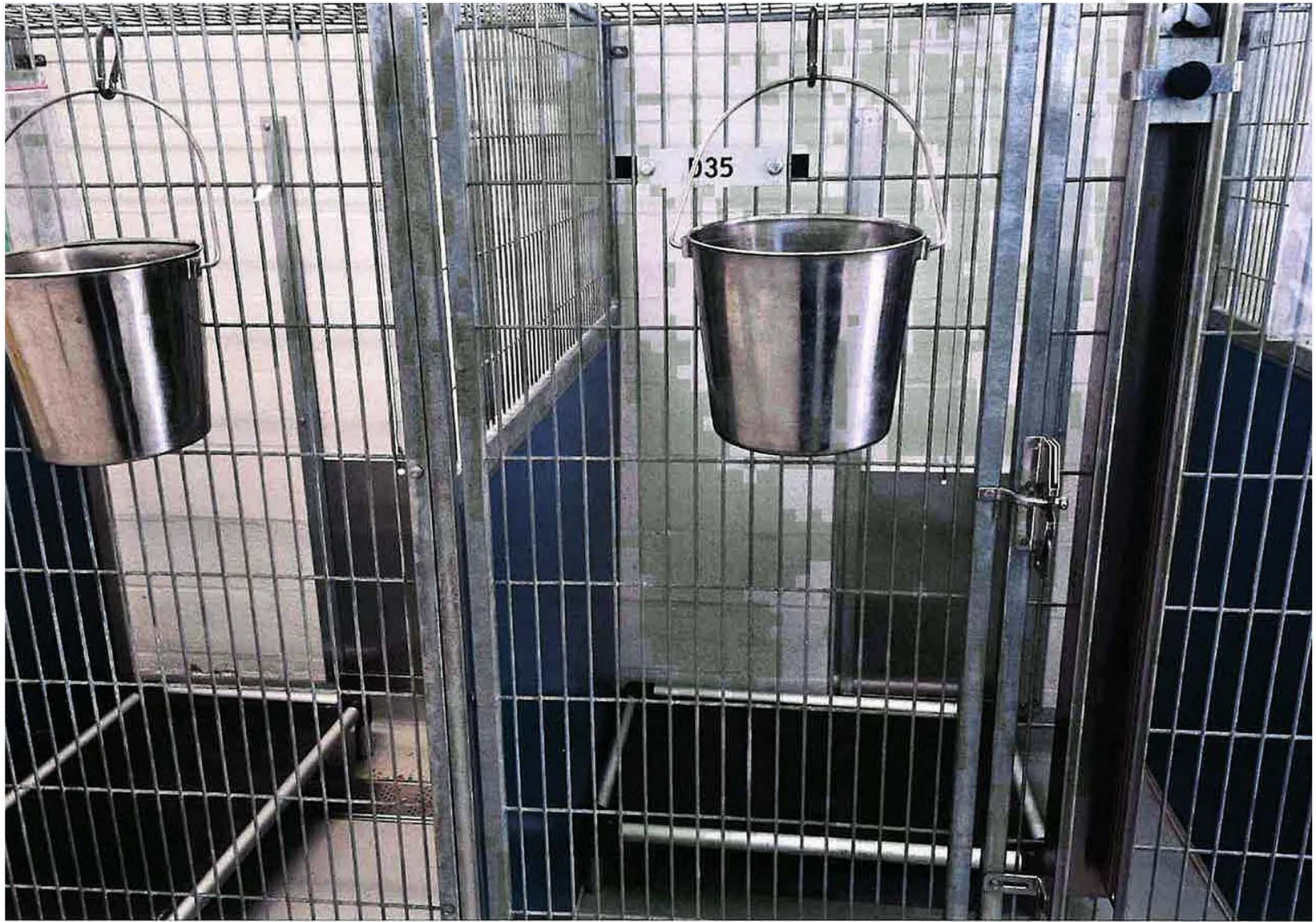

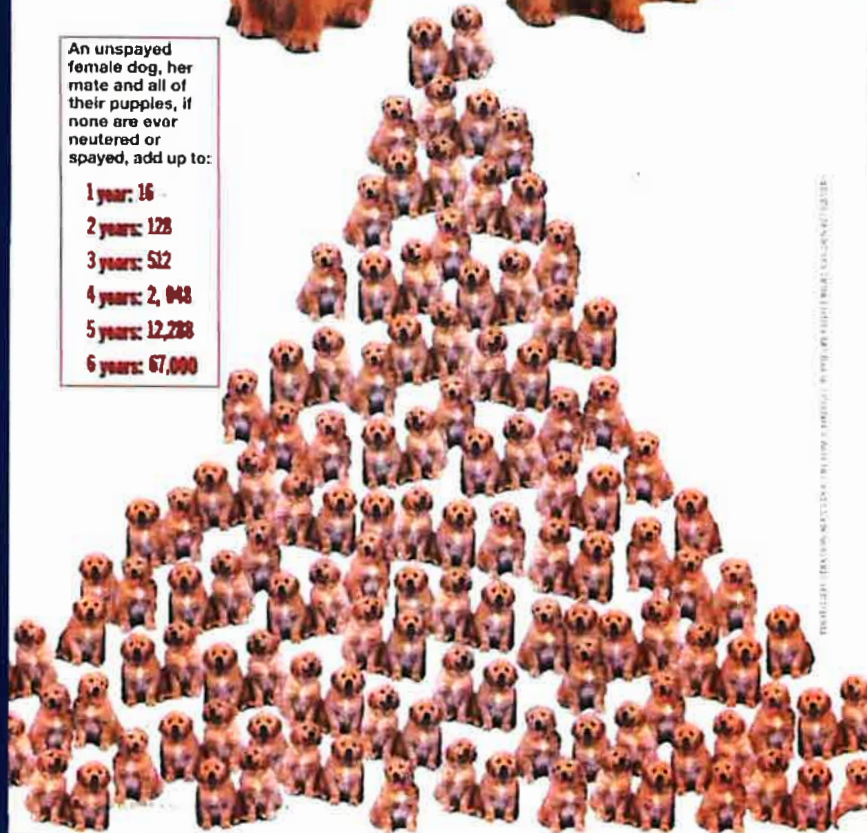






An unspayed female dog, her mate and all of their puppies, if none are ever neutered or spayed, add up to:
