A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, REGARDING NONDISCLOSURE
AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Charter of the City of Fresno, the Mayor shall actively promote economic development to broaden and strengthen the commercial and employment base of the City; and

WHEREAS, often preliminary economic development and land use discussions require or benefit from confidentiality; and

WHEREAS, the Council is vested with all powers not otherwise delegated in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, to perform its function, Council needs access to information that may otherwise be confidential; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter section 803(d), to be effective, all contracts must be approved by the City Attorney as to form.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. Any nondisclosure agreement relating to economic development or land use matters signed by City officials or employees must expressly provide that information covered by the agreement shall be shared with Councilmembers through attorney-client privileged communications.
