A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, SUPPORTING THE
DEVELOPMENT OF A 49 ACRE PARK AT PEACH AND
CALIFORNIA AVENUES AND MAKING IT A PRIORITY FOR
CITY FUNDING

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno owns certain land totaling 49 acres, obtained from the United States of America, as surplus property, known as the Peach/Butler Park Site-CA 1578 (Property), and deeded to the City on October 31, 2006, with the condition that the Property be maintained as a public park or recreation area in perpetuity; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to see this site developed as a public park, in accordance with the deed and grant terms placed on the Property by the National Park Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The Council hereby gives City staff and Administration direction to develop a concept for a multiphase park (the Project) on the Property, along with a funding plan, that satisfies the requirements placed on the Property by the National Park Service.
2. This Resolution shall be effective upon its final approval.
