A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO ADOPT A RESIDENTIAL STREET SPEED HUMP POLICY

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2021, the City Council rescinded a 2006 Pavement Undulation Policy which previously prohibited the installation of new speed humps on City streets, and directed staff to establish a new policy for the installation and removal of speed humps, also commonly referred to as speed bumps, speed tables, and pavement undulations; and

WHEREAS, safe and comfortable streets are a priority for the City of Fresno; and WHEREAS, speed humps are an effective traffic calming measure on residential streets; and

WHEREAS, residents regularly report speeding and request speed hump installations along their blocks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. The City Council adopts the Residential Street Speed Hump Policy attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 2. The City Council directs staff to include speed humps as a traffic calming measure and use the Residential Street Speed Hump Policy to install speed humps when requested according to the provisions contained therein.
  - 3. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
