<u>BACKGROUND OF PROJECT</u> (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

The design phase of this project was initiated in FY20 when the City of Fresno programmed ATP grant funding. The preliminary engineering design and project management was completed over 18 months by City of Fresno staff.

The scope of the project proposes sidewalk, paving and minor water system work along Barton Avenue and Florence Avenue at Calwa Park to infill lengthy gaps in the sidewalk infrastructure that affect the

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local area residents, as well as visitors to Calwa Park. In addition to the sidewalk and roadway work, this project will reconstruct existing park driveways to current standards, provide an ADA-compliant ramp and return at the northwest corner of the park and relocate an existing water check valve for Calwa Park to within the park's fenced perimeter. Currently, Barton Avenue is only half-paved – the east half of the street was never completed, except for a concrete curb that was installed when the park was developed and is otherwise absent paving, gutter and sidewalks. This project will reconstruct Barton Avenue to current city standards. City of Fresno Real Estate staff worked with Calwa Park to complete the dedication of the 30-feet of street right-of-way needed to reconstruct the roadway and curb and gutter as part of this Active Transportation project. Design staff also worked closely with FMFCD to gain concurrence on non-standard roadway grading to provide the needed surface drainage without needing to complete extensive storm drain facility reconstruction work.
