WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to enter into this Second Amendment for an increased monetary consideration not to exceed \$32,000,000 for a total contract value not to exceed \$57,183,393.52 for the life of the Agreement, expiring November 3, 2027; and

WHEREAS, by entry into this Second Amendment, Contractor agrees it has no claim, demand, or dispute with the City.

#### **AGREEMENT**

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recitals, which recitals are contractual in nature, the mutual promises herein contained, and for other good and valuable consideration hereby acknowledged, the parties agree that the aforesaid Agreement be amended as follows:

- 1. Contractor's sole compensation for satisfactory performance for all services required pursuant to this Second Amendment shall be for an increased monetary consideration not to exceed \$32,000,000 for a total contract value not to exceed \$57,183,393.52 for the life of the Agreement, expiring November 3, 2027.
- 2. In the event of any conflict between the body of this Second Amendment and any exhibit or attachment hereto, the terms and conditions of the body of this Second Amendment shall control and take precedence over the terms and conditions expressed within the exhibit or attachment. Furthermore, any terms or conditions contained within any exhibit or attachment hereto which purport to modify the allocation of risk between the Parties, provided for within the body of this Second Amendment, shall be null and void.

3. Except as otherwise specifically set forth in this Second Amendment, the remaining provisions of the First Amendment, dated June 10, 2025, and the Agreement, dated November 3, 2020, shall remain in full force and effect.
