WHEREAS, *The Connections Class “Community Beautification” is an Adult Transition Program that assists disabled young adults ages 18-22 in transitioning into adulthood by giving them the tools to be confident in their abilities as positive community members; and*

WHEREAS, *The “Community Beautification” program is directly aligned with the City’s efforts to Beautify Fresno and it is a way to teach skills such as listening, following directions, and working as a team. Also, furthering knowledge of street and personal safety by using public services such as the Fresno Area Express bus system. Students take pride in developing skills for self-sufficiency. With aid from the Adult Transition Program, they have access to employment opportunities at Storyland to assist with janitorial duties. Also, working with local community churches to fill boxes of food for distribution; and*

WHEREAS, *The ATP staff consists of 1 teacher: Renee Wilkerson, 3 aides: Amanda Monroe, Dawna O’Connell, and Tracey Pules, and 3 administrators: Edward Robinson- site principal, Shant Avakian- program specialist, and Dave Pallughi- director of special education.
