a) The above link will allow you to register in advance for remote participation in the meeting via the Zoom platform. After registering, you will receive a confirmation email containing additional details about joining the meeting.

b) To speak during a Committee meeting, while attending remotely in the Zoom application, click on the icon labeled “Participants” at the bottom of the screen. Then select “RaiseHand” at the bottom of the Participants window. Your digital hand will now be raised. You will be asked to “unmute” when your name is called to speak. You will not be visible via video and there will be no opportunity to share your screen.

PUBLIC COMMENTS –

a) Unless otherwise announced, all public speakers will be limited to 3 minutes.

b) Those addressing the Committee can state their name for the record.

c) To facilitate electronic access, no person shall speak until recognized by the Chair.

d) All participants will be on mute until called upon at which point they will be asked to unmute.

SUBMIT WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS – Residents may also email agenda related documents and comments to be read during the meeting at least 24 hours prior to the agenda item being heard.
