A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO RENAME THE BICYCLE AND
PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE (BPAC) TO THE
ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND
AMEND THE COMMITTEE'S CHARTER

WHEREAS, the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) was established by the City Council on October 8, 2002 to advise the Council on bicycle and pedestrian matters; and

WHEREAS, the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee Charter was approved by the City Council on May 13, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Congress at both the state and national levels have recognized the need to reduce traffic congestion, improve air quality, and reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions; and

WHEREAS, promoting more widespread and efficient active transportation systems are central to balancing the country's multi-modal transportation system; and

WHEREAS, active transportation is travel by human-powered mobility, such as travel by bicycle, foot, and other non-motorized vehicles; and

WHEREAS, active transportation is a viable transportation option in the City of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, the development and implementation of strong active transportation infrastructure and policy including bikeways, walkways, secure bicycle parking, improved access to public transit, intermodal bicycle-transit coordination, and educational programs

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WHEREAS, active transportation is a viable transportation option in the City of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, the development and implementation of strong active transportation infrastructure and policy including bikeways, walkways, secure bicycle parking, improved access to public transit, intermodal bicycle-transit coordination, and educational programs for cyclists, pedestrians and drivers to promote the safe sharing of public roadways must be given a priority in transportation planning; and

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WHEREAS, the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee proposes to update the charter and change the committee name to the Active Transportation Advisory Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The City Council shall acknowledge the update to the charter.
2. The City Council shall acknowledge the name change of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee to the Active Transportation Advisory Committee.
3. The Mission of the Active Transportation Advisory Committee shall be to advise the City Council on active transportation matters to make Fresno a more active transportation friendly city.
4. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
