A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF \$17,406 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION FOR THE FRESNO POLICE DEPARTMENT'S 2023 OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE GRANT

WHEREAS, the Fresno Police Department (grant applicant) desires to undertake a project for the education and enforcement of off-highway vehicle related laws and regulations to be funded in part from state grant funds made available through the 2023 Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) grant program administered by the State of California Department Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, the procedures established by the OHV grant require that, when selected for funding, the grant applicant is to submit a resolution from its governing board authorizing the grant applicant to enter into a contract with the State of California (Grant Agreement) and execute related documents; and

WHEREAS, the governing body approves the receiving of grant funding from the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation for the Fresno Police Department's 2023 OHV Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The Chief of Police for the City of Fresno is authorized on its behalf to sign the Grant Agreement, including any extensions or amendments thereof, subject to prior approval as to form by the City Attorney's Office. This authorization extends to

amendments that add additional funds to the original contract, subject to approval by this governing body of an amendment to the City's appropriations resolution.

2. The City of Fresno agrees to abide by the statutes and regulations governing the OHV grant program, as well as, the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation. Any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, will be the responsibility of the City of Fresno.

3. The grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this governing body.

4. This Resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
