A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO MAKING THE EIGHTEENTH AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 2025-177 ENTITLED "A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO ESTABLISHING RULES FOR THE APPLICATION OF CITY EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION RATES AND SCHEDULES AND RELATED REQUIREMENTS, AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION RATES AND SCHEDULES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Fresno, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Exhibit 8, Unit 8, Non-Represented, is hereby amended to increase the salary range from \$16.50 - \$20.50 to \$16.90 - \$20.90 per hour for the Cashier Clerk, Lifeguard, Intern, Youth Jobs Corps Program Ambassador and Youth Jobs Corps Program Participant classifications, effective January 1, 2026.

SECTION 2.

Exhibit 8, Unit 8, Non-Represented, is hereby amended to increase the salary range from \$16.50 - \$21.50 to \$16.90 - \$21.90 per hour for the Police Cadet I classification, effective January 1, 2026.

SECTION 3.

Exhibit 8, Unit 8, Non-Represented, is hereby amended to increase the minimum salary from \$16.50 to \$16.90 per hour for the Services Aide and Sports Official classifications, effective January 1, 2026.

SECTION 4.

Upon final legislative approval, this Resolution shall become effective January 1, 2026.
