The Budget Allocation for this expenditure is \$172,500 . The contract price is 16.86 % above/below the Budget Allocation. If the overage is greater than 10% or only one bid was received, give explanation:

The overage is greater than 10% due to a significant model year design change. The product specified is the first pursuit rated hybrid Police SUV to market. This design change delayed published pricing for all model year 2020 Interceptor Utilities. There were no comparable products available to reference for accurate costing at the time the FY20 Budget was being prepared. Receiving only one bid is likely due to the solicitation of a low quantity of units.

Purchasing these five hybrid patrol units will provide valuable information regarding the benefits and deficiencies of implementing a hybrid powertrain in a Police Patrol vehicle.
