Background (Explain the need for the procurement below.)

The Bigby Villa Park Improvements Project is necessary to enhance public safety, accessibility, and recreational amenities at Bigby Villa Park, located in Council district 3.

The scope of work includes installation of new park benches, waste receptacles, temporary Measure P signage, a shade sail structure over the play area, ADA-compliant deepened concrete edge, removal and replacement of the existing play structure with a new play structure, replacement of existing wood mulch surfacing with poured-in-place rubber surface subgrade, and accessibility improvements to enhance the park guest experience.

Design for the Project was initiated through a consultant agreement with O'Dell Engineering Inc. on May 3, 2023, for the preparation of construction documents. The improvements are funded through Fiscal Year 2026 appropriations from Measure P and the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
