## OPIOID EDUCATION AND NALOXONE DISTRIBUTION (OEND)



The **Opioid Education and Naloxone Distribution (OEND)** program was designed to reduce opioid overdose deaths in Fresno County by providing a combination of education and harm reduction resources to the community. Our program directly provides opioid and overdose education, training on reversal medication, fentanyl testing strips, and referrals to social services.
