A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, RENAMING THE ROEDING DOG
PARK RUN TO "PUPPY LOVE" DOG PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno owns the regional park located at 890 West Belmont Avenue, commonly known as Roeding Park; and

WHEREAS, there is currently a dog park located inside Roeding Park, which contains a dog run (Dog Park); and

WHEREAS, the Dog Park, which is a neighborhood hub, particularly for those residents located in District 3, bringing together both pets and their owners; and

WHEREAS, pet owners who gather at the Dog Park have advocated for better conditions and amenities at the facility; and

WHEREAS, the Dog Park has undergone recent renovations and upgrades; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Fresno Municipal Code Section 5-101 the Council has the ability to name or rename public facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The Dog Park currently known as Roeding Dog Park Run shall hereafter be named "Puppy Love" Dog Park.
2. This Resolution is adopted in accordance with Section 8 of Administrative Order 6-2.
3. The provisions of Resolution No. 2020-272 shall be waived with respect to this Resolution.

4. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
